Analysing and creating persuasive texts

Students read, view and analyse persuasive texts. They examine ways persuasive language features are used to influence an audience. Students use this language to create their own persuasive texts.

Investigating characters

Students listen to, view and read a variety of short narrative texts to explore the authors' use of descriptive language to construct characters. They write a short imaginative narrative.

Health & PE **Good friends**



Students investigate how emotional responses vary and understand how being a good friend helps them to interact positively with others in a variety of situations. They recognise strategies for managing change and identify how meeting challenges strengthens identity.

Students develop the fundamental movement skills of running, jumping and throwing. They also explore the benefits of physical activity to health and wellbeing.


