

English Enjoying our world

Prep Term I

Students listen to and read texts to explore predictable structures and common visual patterns in a range of literary and non-literary texts, including fiction and non-fiction books and everyday texts. They respond to a familiar story by drawing and speaking in an informal setting.

Students explore letters and sounds in words as well as correct letter formation. They write signs, labels, lists and explore sentence writing and experiment with capital letters and fullstops.

Design & Technologies **Old Macdonald's** Farm

Students explore how plants and animals are grown for food, clothing and shelter and how food is selected and prepared for healthy eating.

They design solutions for a farm to enable successful food and fibre production and make a food product from garden produce.

The Arts Music



Students explore singing, movement and beat through the use of songs, games and musical instruments.

Drama



Students participate in drama activities to explore a range of drama elements including voice and movement.

Students explore information about what makes them unique and their strengths and achievements.

Science Our living world

Students use their senses to observe the needs of living things, both animals and plants. They analyse different types of environments and how each provides for the needs of living things. Students share ideas about how they can support and protect living things in the school grounds.

Students explore important events celebrated in their lives, and identify how people and objects help them to remember. They sequence familiar events in order and respond to questions about their own past.
