## English

### Reading, writing and exploring poetry

Students read and listen to a range of poems to create a poetry innovation. They present their poem or rhyme to a familiar audience.

### Stories of families and friends

Students explore texts to analyse how stories convey a message about issues that relate to families and friends. They write an imaginative new narrative about family and/or friendship.



## Health & PE

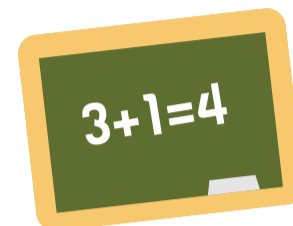
### My classroom is healthy, safe and fun

Students investigate the concept of health and the foods and activities that make them healthy. They identify actions that keep themselves and others healthy and safe in and outside their classroom. Students explore elements of movement while developing fundamental movement skills that involve manipulating equipment such as hoops and balls.



## Maths

### Focus



#### Number

- order, represent 2 and 3-digit numbers, partition and combine numbers flexibly

#### Space

- locate and identify positions on maps and use familiar mathematical language

#### Statistics

- build the foundations for statistical inquiry by choosing questions based on interests when collecting, representing and interpreting data, and recognising features of different representations
- develop a sense of equivalence, chance and variability when engaging in play-based and practical activities

## The Arts

### Music



Students explore music through singing, playing instruments and movement. They also learn to read rhythmic patterns and perform these on percussion instruments.

### Drama



Students explore role and dramatic action in dramatic play, improvisation and process drama.

## Science

### Mix, make and use



Students investigate combinations of different materials and give reasons for the selection of particular materials according to their properties and purpose. They describe changes made to materials when combining them to make an object that has a purpose in everyday life. Students pose questions, make predictions and follow instructions to record observations in a guided investigation.



## Digital Technologies

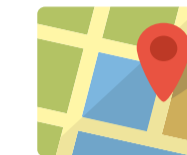
### Data detectives

Students learn and apply Digital Technologies knowledge and skills through guided play and tasks integrated into other subject areas. They also learn the parts of a keyboard and explore the use of basic ICT skills.

### Present connections to places



- *How are people connected to their place and other places?*

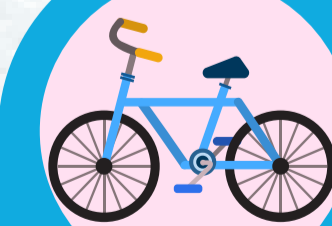
Students describe a site of significance in the local community and explain why places are important to people. They recognise why significant features of places should be preserved.
